


# CMF

### Colour, Material, Finish

CMF (Colour, Material, Finish) discipline focuses on analysing and developing materials based on their colour, material and texture. This perspective allows us to approach the possibilities of this collection of decorative surfaces by classifying the materials according to:

- The colour palette to which they belong.
- Technical possibilities of the materials.
- Grouping according to the type of surface texture.

In this way, decision-making for furniture or interior design will be much simpler and will exploit the transforming power of a correct selection of materials, taking into account the decorative and technical qualities that directly influence how we perceive the habitat.





Smart Creativity exploits two styles through Optimistic Design and Colour Functionality. We invite you to discover them on the following pages.




